Phoenix – the immortal bird

I am delighted to come to the “Phoenix Cup” 2014 again witnessing the top level international women’s baseball event with teams from different places of the world.

The Hong Kong Baseball Association chose the word “ phoenix” to name this high level tournament is very meaningful as “phoenix” in the Chinese culture has three connotations:


First, phoenix coupling with dragon, is a totem of Chinese people. While dragon relates to strength and “Yang” represents masculinity, whereas phoenix to tenderness and “Yin” femininity. Naming of the world class women’s baseball tournament after phoenix, the supreme image of woman, is the most suitable representation.

Second, in the eyes of the Chinese people, phoenix is a bird of morality. It represents fortune, nobleness, beauty, courage and freedom. All kinds of glorification are attached to phoenix.

Third, there is an eulogy for phoenix. Phoenix in mythology has a great power of life that revives from ash. Christianity is the only religion that has a concept of rebirth. Just because of the belief, the old life being immersed in water, and when man comes out of the water he becomes a new person with an eternal life. Phoenix on the other hand goes into the fire, rises from the ashes and becomes the immortal bird. Could there possibly be any better symbol for women’s baseball, a sport which once been depreciated and marginalized, yet unyieldingly stood up and gained a foothold in the pantheon of world sports after more than twenty years?

The above three connotations, especially the last one, comes to my mind in the wake of the striving story of the Hong Kong Women’s Baseball Team.

Fly, phoenix fly, in the name of yourself, you beautiful immortal bird!

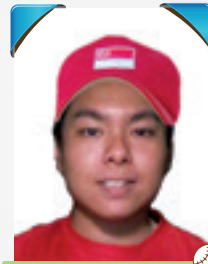


SG Panthers Singapore
